A BILL

To amend the Higher Education Act of 1965 to prohibit institutions of higher education that authorize Anti-Semitic events on campus from participating in the student loan and grant programs under title IV of such Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stop Anti-Semitism
5 on College Campuses Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION OF ANTISEMITIC EVENTS ON CAM-**
2 **PUS.**

3 Section 487(a) of the Higher Education Act of 1965
4 (20 U.S.C. 1094(a)) is amended by adding at the end the
5 following:

6 “(30)(A) The institution will not authorize, fa-
7 cilitate, provide funding for, or otherwise support
8 any event promoting Anti-Semitism on campus.

9 “(B) In this paragraph, the term ‘Anti-Semi-
10 tism’ has the meaning given the working definition
11 of Anti-Semitism adopted by the International Holo-
12 caust Remembrance Alliance on May 26, 2016, in-
13 cluding the contemporary examples of Anti-Semitism
14 cited by the Alliance.”.
